

Internet Privacy Statement

Clear Harbor, LLC and its affiliates and subsidiaries (collectively, "Clear Harbor", "we" or "us") are committed to protecting your privacy. This privacy policy will advise you as to how we protect your personal information. Please read this policy carefully. We may change our privacy policy from time to time in order to deal with new issues or procedures. We will post changes to our privacy policy at this site, and such changes will be effective with respect to personal information we collect after the change is posted. Please refer back to this policy regularly. We will not collect personal identifying information about you unless you request us to send you information or unless you apply for a job through this site. In such cases, we may collect and retain personal information about you such as your name, email address, mailing address, phone number, the information you request, work history, education and any other information you may provide in conjunction with your request or job application. We may use your personal information for our own direct marketing purposes, but we will give you the opportunity to "opt out" of receiving such marketing. We will not sell or give your personal information to any outside company for marketing or solicitation purposes. We will preserve the confidentiality of your personal information and it will be used solely to respond to your request and any future request and to any job application you may submit through this site. We may have to disclose your personal information to third parties providing IT services to us or to our business partners or vendors providing us services or products, but will do so only with appropriate confidentiality agreements in place.

We maintain reasonable safeguards to protect the confidentiality of all of your personal information. However, as is the case with all computer networks linked to the internet, we cannot guarantee the security of information provided over the internet and will not be responsible for breaches of security beyond our reasonable control. Also, please keep in mind that if you directly disclose any personally identifying information through any chat room, message board or other public online forum maintained or accessed through this site, such information may be collected and used by others. Finally, we reserve the right to transfer any personal information to any company that purchases Clear Harbor or its assets.

When you access our site, we may also collect information about you in the following ways:

(A) We will collect non-personal information that is sent to us automatically by your web browser, including the IP address of your internet service provider, your type of operating system (e.g. Macintosh® or Windows®) and the name and version of your browser (e.g. Internet Explorer® or Firefox®). You can check your browser if you wish to learn what information your browser sends and how to change your settings.

(B) We may use a "session cookie." A session cookie is used to tag your computer with a unique identifier while you access our site at any one time. A session cookie does not identify you personally and expires after you close your browser. Session cookies enable us to collect statistical data about the ways visitors use our site, such as which pages they visit, which links they use and how long they stay on a page. This information is used primarily to enable us to modify our website to make it more user-friendly and more responsive to our customers' needs and wishes.

(C) We may also use "persistent cookies." Persistent cookies do not expire when you close your browser and will stay on your computer until you take action to delete them. A persistent cookie assigns a unique identifier to your computer and permits us to create and use a database of your previous choices, preferences and personal information you may have previously provided us. A persistent cookie allows us to quickly and automatically access that information and results in better service to you.

You have the right to set your browser not to accept cookies or to alert you when a cookie is placed on your computer. If your browser rejects cookies, you may not be able to access or utilize all features of our web site.

Our site may have links to internet sites not operated by Clear Harbor. These links are provided as a service and do not imply any endorsement of the products, services or content of these sites or any affiliation or association with the owners of these sites. We do not control these other sites and are not responsible for their privacy policies.
